1	Charge My Street	After an on site meeting with CMS and Alan Hulme, CMS have agreed to do some more remedial work to put the car park ground back properly. Meanwhile, they have also been chasing ENWL for a connection date so that the chargers can be commissioned.	For Info
2	Flowbird EV	I have now received the amended quote from ENWL with regard to the proposed Flowbird EV install which allows me to get a corrected quote from David Pearce.	For Info
3	Restart Grant	I have applied for the Restart Grant in respect of the toilets and hope to hear about this shortly.	For Info
4	School Boiler Loan	I have received a cheque from the school governors in final payment of the loan.	For Info
