



Dent Village Car Park

Terms and Conditions of Use

General Terms

The car park in Dent Village is managed by Dent with Cowgill Parish Council ("The Council"), with profits being used to fund other projects and voluntary organisations within Dentdale.

Use of the car park is solely at the discretion of The Council, who reserves the right to refuse admission to any person or vehicle.

Parking of vehicles on the car park is solely at the risk of the owner and The Council accepts no liability for any damage or theft that may occur on the car park.

In choosing to park on the car park you accept the charges as specified at the time of parking on the Pay and Display machine near the entrance of the car park (unless you have a valid permit to park).

Vehicles must be parked in marked bays and in a responsible manner, so as not to obstruct any other user of the car park.

Only holders of valid blue badges may park in the marked disabled bays.

Only Electric Vehicles may park in bays marked as "Electric Vehicles Only" and only whilst receiving a charge. Once charged these vehicles should be moved to another bay to allow other users to use the charge point

Parking Tariffs

The relevant tariffs for parking on the car park are displayed on the pay and display machine near the entrance.

The relevant tariffs are:

Up to 1 hour	£1.50
Up to 2 hours	£2.50
Up to 3 hours	£3.20
Up to 4 hours	£4.00
Up to 24 hours	£5.00
5 day long stay ticket	£20.00
7 day long stay ticket	£30.00

Disabled badge holders and motorcycles may park free of charge.

Residents Parking Permits

Permits are available for residents of Dentdale who can use the car park free of charge.

Resident means anyone who is currently living in the dale and who is registered on the electoral roll for Dent with Cowgill Parish.

Residents who meet this criteria can apply for a permit by contacting the Clerk to the Council at clerk@dentwithcowgillpc.co.uk

People who believe they are resident but not on the electoral roll should speak to the clerk.

Transferable Permits

With effect from 01 January 2022, transferable permits have been withdrawn by the council and will no longer be issued. Anyone using the car park, who is not a resident (as defined above) will be expected to purchase a ticket from the machine.

Motorhomes & Campervans

Long-term parking of motorhomes and campervans of any size, is restricted to residents of the dale only at the absolute discretion of the council, and only upon purchase of a Motorhome/campervan Permit by application to the Clerk to the Council at clerk@dentwithcowgillpc.co.uk

Each motorhome will have a marked, designated bay in which to park and there will be a maximum of 6 bays available.

Motorhome permits must be renewed annually on 01 January at a cost of £300.00. No discounts are given for late renewal/purchase and no refunds are given for early disposal. Short term parking for non-residents i.e. tourists is permitted at standard day rates where the vehicle fits in a standard bay and twice the day rate if the vehicle crosses more than one bay.

The occupation of motorhomes/campervans overnight remains strictly forbidden.

Commercial Vehicles/Vans

Parking of commercial vehicles or vans on the car park is at the sole discretion of The Council and is by prior arrangement only.

This service will only be available to residents (as defined above) of Dentdale and the council reserves the right to make a charge for this service.

Coaches/Minibuses

There will be one marked coach bay which will be available on a first come/first served basis. The charge for parking will be £25 per day or part thereof.

Electric Vehicle Charging

Electric Vehicle charge points are provided for use by visitors and residents.

The Council asks that EV drivers only park their vehicle in the designated bays if they are using the charge point. If the vehicle is not being charged or when the vehicle has completed charging, the vehicle must be moved to another parking bay, so that other users may charge their vehicle.

The only exception to this rule, applies to residents only, whereby parking of electric vehicles is allowed, for overnight to charging.

Under no circumstances must EV bays be used by non-electric vehicles.
