Purpose of the Report

To recommend to full council that the recycling area on the car park needs some reorganisation and down-sizing and to suggest that 6 banks be removed.

Recommendation

Option 2 - To remove four glass recycling banks and two can recycling banks and to make the new recycling area longer and narrower to improve traffic access.

Context

As part of the wider Car Park improvement Project the recycling area is being improved with a new surface and a wall and fence around it. The current recycling area is too big and needs to be made smaller.

Background

The recycling area is provided for the convenience of residents and visitors. All residents have a kerbside recycling provision which should reduce the need for them to use the recycling area in the car park. On inspection the banks are only partially full (with the exception of cardboard) and can be reduced without impact.

Financial Implications

Options considered

1. Leave the recycling area as it is – this is not feasible as SLDC want to see the surface improved to stop injuries to collection operatives.
2. Remove four glass recycling banks and two can recycling banks
3. Remove all of the recycling banks

The Policy and Resource Committee recommends that the council trial bi-monthly meetings until the end of the current financial year.
