The group were looking to make a promotional leaflet, promoting the whole Dale and was requesting that the PC pay half of the costs toward this. Cllr. Mitchell noted that funding may be available from YDNPA or Visit Yorkshire. RESOLVED that happy to support in principle but should await the outcome of discussions with YDNPA and Visit Yorkshire.
