1	Car Park Consultation	We received four responses to the consultation and the results will be discussed at the Policy and Resources meeting on 25 May.	For Info
2	Grants	I have had 3 requests for grants outside of the normal cycle and these will be considered at the Policy and Resources meeting on 25 May.	For Info
3	EV Chargers	The EV Chargers have now been installed and ENWL have made the connection. However, at the last minute I was told that I need to find a supplier who will then install a meter (I assumed ENWL did this) and so there is now a further delay. I have contacted several suppliers but have not had much joy. I am currently awaiting a call back from two suppliers.	For Info
4	Charge My Street	Charge My Street have advised that they will not be doing any further work on the car park as their project is over and there is no further funding available. I have obtained photographs from Alan Hulme of how the car park was before the work and have sent them to CMS along with the original lease that they produced which clearly states that the car park must be put back as it was. 5	Year End	I have prepared all of the year end paperwork and the internal auditor visited on 25 April. Her report and the other necessary paperwork is to be signed off at this meeting.	For Info
6	Bench at Stonehouse	The public bench at Stonehouse is in need of repair. I have asked Jeff Clegg to quote for the repair and this will be available at the Amenities and Environment meeting on 16 May.	For Info
7	Sepia Barn	The case is to be heard on 27 June 2022, likely via video conference. I am putting together all relevant evidence to send to the court.	For Info
8	Winter Signage at Deepdale	Highways have relented and have suggested a new sign on the opposite side of the road. I think a better solution would be to move the sign further up the road where it can be placed facing traffic. I have suggested this to Highways.	For Info
9	Footway Lights	I have asked Ian Hutt to commence work on the light upgrade starting with the lights at Bath House, Church Gate Cottage, Dragon Croft, St Andrews Church. Two more lights will be replaced this year.	For Info
10	Car Park Improvement Project	After the meeting on 10 March, I finally received information from YDNPA to go on the new information boards in April. I have tried to contact Matt Kaunz without success to find out where the boards are up to. The car park consultant has commenced work and will hopefully be able to provide initial findings shortly.
