1	Bench at Reading Room	I am awaiting confirmation from the Reading Room Committee that they are happy for the bench to be placed outside.	For Info
2	Defibrillator	The defibrillator at Greenwell has now been installed.	For Info
3	EV Chargers	The EV Chargers have finally gone live. Signage is to be added once the correct brackets have been supplied. The tariff is set at 50 pence per kWh to begin with. I have had two complaints regarding the lights associated with the chargers which will be on the agenda for discussion at the Policy and Resources Committee on 14 November.	For Info

9	Ticket Machine Maintenance	New software along with the new tariffs have been installed in the machine. I managed to negotiate this free of charge given the issues we have had with the machine. It is now not possible to pay more than the £5 daily charge without pressing a specific button which should eliminate the problems we have had. A new tariff label and sign have been ordered.	For Info
10	Car Park Improvement Project	Recycling Area – The new surface has now been installed. A fence will be installed shortly to make this area look a lot neater.
