1	Footway Lighting	All lights have now been delivered and Ian Hutt has begun installing some of the modern ones at Flintergill and Dragon Croft. A complaint has been received regarding the suitability of the lights and I have responded. I am awaiting a further response from the complainant.	For Info
2	Ticket Machine	I have written to Flowbird again advising that the council will accept it's offer of 6 months free maintenance but that we feel this does not go far enough. I am awaiting a response.	For Info
3	Drainage Issues	Graham Bradley has been instructed to carry out the repair work as soon as possible. New drainage pipe will run through the ladies toilet to the manhole in the bus shelter as this was the easiest route to take. Separate new pipes will then run from the disabled toilet and gents to the existing manhole outside. This will remove all waste from the existing broken pipes.	For Info
4	Bonfire and Fireworks	Fireworks have been delivered and all of the arrangements have been made. I have yet to collect the donation pots. Food will be being served from 6pm.	For Info
5	Car Park Improvement Project	The timber solution for marking of the bays did not work. I am currently trying to find another solution but I am conscious that this needs to be completed ASAP. I am chasing Matt Kaunz and Clare Tyas regarding the information boards. I still need to visit the school and speak with the WI regarding the Wildflower area.	For Info
6	Beech Hill	A short brief has been sent to Ian Kitson as discussed at the recent Amenities and Environment Committee meeting. I am awaiting a response from him.	For Info
7	The Green	The power washing of the green is not satisfactory with only small areas seeming to have been done. The grass at the edge of the green has not yet been cut back. I continue to chase up the Locality team at Westmorland and Furness Council for action on this.	For Info
