958	/25	<p><b>Landslip at Dent Head:</b> Cllr. Mitchell noted that tarmac would be laid in the next week, weather permitting. It was noted that there was a missed opportunity for a passing place with tarmac not being laid up to the wall.</p>

Povey expressed disappointment that the application above Ghyllside had not gone any further and that more than anything Dent needs more houses. He noted that the business starter units seemed a good idea and noted that the response doesn't say anything about the community or school. It was noted that the application above Ghyllside was mainly for open market housing and what Dent needs is affordable housing.</p>
